Psalm 106:10 "He saved them from the hand of the foe; from the hand of the enemy he redeemed them."

II. Redeemed from the _____ of the _____

Galatians 3:23 (NirV) Christ set us free from the curse of the law. He did it by becoming a curse for us. It is written, "Everyone who is hung on a pole is under God's curse." (Deuteronomy 21:23)

III. Released from _____ to Sin and Iniquity

Micah 6:4 For I brought you up from the land of Egypt, I redeemed you from the house of bondage."

IV. Repaid with _____ Compensation.

1 Peter 1:18-19 "For you know that God paid a ransom to save you from the empty life you inherited from your ancestors. And it was not paid with mere gold or silver, which lose their value. ¹⁹ It was the precious blood of Christ, the sinless, spotless Lamb of God."

OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECIES ABOUT JESUS

7. He would be a descendant of Jacob's son Judah

Genesis 49:10 The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from his descendants, until the coming of the one to whom it belongs, the one whom all nations will honor. Mt. 1:2-3

8. He would be a descendant of Jesse, a descendant of Judah

Isaiah 11:1-10 ²And the Spirit of the Lord will rest on him—the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord. ¹⁰ In that day the heir to David's throne will be a banner of salvation to all the world. The nations will rally to him, and the land where he lives will be a glorious place. See Matt. 1:2-3

9. He would be a descendant of Jesse's son King David

Isaiah 11:1 "Out of the stump of David's family will grow a shoot—yes, a new Branch bearing fruit from the old root." See Matt. 1:1

10. He would appear after a succession of rulers from the Tribe of Judah

Genesis 49:10 (Message) The scepter shall not leave Judah; he'll keep a firm grip on the command staff. Until the ultimate ruler comes and the nations obey him.

History: Josephus writes that King Herod's son was dethroned in 6 A.D. and replaced by a Roman Procurator.

11. He would appear after the rebuilding of Jerusalem.

Daniel 9:25 Listen and understand! Seven sets of seven plus sixty-two sets of seven will pass from the time the command is given to rebuild Jerusalem until a ruler—the Anointed One—comes. Jerusalem will be rebuilt with streets and strong defenses, despite the perilous times.

History: Jerusalem had been rebuilt by the time of Jesus, after recovering from the Babylonian destruction.
