I. The Person of Peace

A. _____ **Personifies Peace.**
Isaiah 9:6-7a “For a child is born to us, a son is given to us. The government will rest on his shoulders. And he will be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, **Prince of Peace**. His government and its peace will never end.”

B. Jesus’ _____ **Assures Peace.**
Mark 4:38 - 39 “Jesus was sleeping at the back of the boat with his head on a cushion. The disciples woke him up, shouting, “Teacher, don’t you care that we’re going to drown?”³⁹ When Jesus woke up, he rebuked the wind and said to the waves, “Silence! Be still!” Suddenly the wind stopped, and there was a great calm.

2 Thessalonians 3:16 “Now may the Lord of peace himself give you his peace at all times and in every situation. The Lord be with you all.”

Romans 14:17 (NLV) “For the holy nation of God is not food and drink. It is being right with God. It is peace and joy given by the Holy Spirit.”

Romans 5:1 “Since we have been made right in God’s sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us.”

John 3:36 (VOICE) “Those who believe in the Son will bask in eternal life, but those who disobey the Son will never experience life. They will know only God’s lingering wrath.”

Acts 10:36 “This is the message of Good News (Gospel) for the people of Israel—that there is peace with God through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all.” See also Colossians 1:19-21

Romans 15:13a “I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in him.

John 14:27 (Passion) “I leave the gift of **peace** with you—my peace. Not the kind of fragile peace given by the world, but my perfect peace. Don’t yield to **fear or be troubled** in your hearts—instead, be courageous!”

IV. The Purpose of Peace

Psalms 29:11 (TPT) “This is the one who gives his strength and might to his people. This is the Lord giving us his kiss of peace”

John 16:32-33 “But the time is coming—indeed it’s here now—when you will be scattered, each one going his own way, leaving me alone. Yet I am not alone because the Father is with me.³³ I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world.”

A. **God’s Peace** _____ **Us**

Philippians 4:7 (Passion) “Then God’s wonderful peace that transcends human understanding, will make the answers known to you through Jesus Christ.”

Colossians 3:15 (Amp) Let the peace of Christ - the inner calm of one who walks daily with Him - be the controlling factor in your hearts deciding and settling questions that arise. To this peace indeed you were called as members in one body of believers. And be thankful to God always.

B. God's Peace _____ **Our Minds**

Philippians 4:6-7 "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank him for all he has done. ⁷Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus."

Romans 8:5-6 Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. ⁶So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace.

Matthew 5:9 "God blesses those who work for peace, for they will be called the children of God."

Ephesians 6:15 (TPT) "Stand on your feet alert, then you'll always be ready to share the blessings of peace."

Luke 10:5-6 (TPT) "Once you enter a house, speak to the people there and say, 'God's blessing of peace be upon this house!' ⁶ If a lover of peace resides there, your peace will rest upon that household. But if you are rejected, your blessing of peace will come back upon you.

Romans 16:20 "The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. May the grace of our Lord Jesus be with you."
