## B. God has a \_\_\_\_\_ for us

Ephesians 1:11-12 (Msg) "It's in Christ that we find out who we are and what we are living for. Long before we first heard of Christ and got our hopes up, he had his eye on us, had designs on us for glorious living, part of the overall purpose he is working out in everything and everyone."

Key: Self-focus never reveals life's purpose. God is not just the starting point of your life, He is the source of your life.

Jeremiah 29:13-14 (Message) "When you come looking for me, you'll find me. "Yes, when you get serious about finding me and want it more than anything else, I'll make sure you won't be disappointed." God's Decree. "I'll turn things around for you. I'll bring you back from all the countries into which I drove you"—God's Decree—"bring you home to the place from which I sent you off into exile.
