Exodus 7:3,5 But I will make Pharaoh's heart stubborn so I can multiply my miraculous signs and wonders in the land of Egypt. <sup>5</sup> When I raise my powerful hand and bring out the Israelites, the Egyptians will know that I am the Lord.

Exodus 9:8-11 "<sup>9</sup> The *ashes* will spread like fine dust over the whole land of Egypt, causing festering boils to break out on people and animals throughout the land."

7. Plague of Hail Exodus 9:18-19 "I will send a hailstorm more devastating than any in all the history of Egypt. <sup>19</sup> Quick! Order your livestock and servants to come in from the fields to find shelter. Any person or animal left outside will die when the hail falls."

8. Plague of locust Exodus 10:4-6 "Tomorrow I will bring a swarm of locusts on your country.<sup>5</sup> They will cover the land so that you won't be able to see the ground. They will devour what little is left of your crops after the hailstorm, including all the trees growing in the fields.

9. Plague of darkness Exodus 10:21-23 <sup>23b</sup> But there was light as usual where the people of Israel lived."

10. The death of the first-born Exodus 11:4-5 <sup>5</sup> All the firstborn sons will die in every family in Egypt, from the oldest son of Pharaoh, who sits on his throne, to the oldest son of his lowliest servant girl who grinds the flour. Even the firstborn of all the livestock will die.

b. Pharaoh was worshipped as a god.

3. Pride led to Lucifer's rebellion in heaven

Isaiah 14:12-14 "How you are fallen from heaven, O shining star, son of the morning! You have been thrown down to the earth, you who destroyed the nations of the world. <sup>13</sup> For you said to yourself, 'I will ascend to heaven and set my throne above God's stars. I will preside on the mountain of the gods far away in the north. <sup>14</sup> I will climb to the highest heavens and be like the Most High."

4. Satan works through pride to deceive and capture us.
