Can you pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? ¹⁷A good tree produces good fruit, and a bad tree produces bad fruit. ¹⁸A good tree can't produce bad fruit, and a bad tree can't produce good fruit. ¹⁹So every tree that does not produce good fruit is chopped down and thrown into the fire. ²⁰Yes, just as you can identify a tree by its fruit, so you can identify people by their actions.

II. _____ Intimacy = Ability to safely share thoughts, ideas, & perspectives. Allows acceptance of the way another person thinks without demanding conformity.

III. _____ Intimacy = The security to share our feelings, dreams, doubts, fears, and insecurities.

IV. _____ Intimacy - provides a sense of unity and mutual commitment to God's purpose for our lives, along with a respect for the special dreams of each other's hearts. It's the greatest depth of intimacy we experience.
