## I Am David - Lessons in Greatness - Week 3


I. David was an worshiper.		
A. He was physically, expressing himself through song and psalm, an extravagant lover of God.		
2 Sam.6:13-15 After the men who were carrying the Ark of the Lord had gone six steps, David sacrificed a bull and a fattened calf. <sup>14</sup> And David danced before the Lord with all his might, wearing a priestly garment. <sup>15</sup> So David and all the people of Israel brought up the Ark of the Lord with shouts of joy and the blowing of rams' horns.

A. God referred to David as a man after His own heart.		
1 Samuel 13:14 the Lord has sought out a man after his own heart. The Lord has already appointed him to be the leader of his people.		
Acts 13:22 God removed Saul and replaced him with David, a man about whom God said, 'I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart. He will do everything I want him to do.
